 1. Eradication of Child Labour and Rehabilitation of children and expansion of Rural Labour Welfare Centres

 1. To take suitable measures for identification of child labour and for their rehabilitation.
 2. To Give training to women folk in tailoring and handicraft for their upliftment and running Child Welfare Centres for the care of the children in labour oriented areas.
