Chief Secretariat (Education) – Higher and Technical Education – Introduction of Lateral Entry admission to M.C.A. Degree programme from the academic year 2015-16 onwards in all the Government Colleges, Professional and Arts and Science Colleges run by Government sponsored Societies, Unaided Private Professional Colleges approved by the All India Council for Technical Education, New Delhi and also affiliated to Pondicherry University and to the M.C.A. degree programme offered in constituent Colleges of the Deemed Universities functioning in the Union Territory of Puducherry – Orders – Issued.

ORDER :

The Director of Higher and Technical Education, Puducherry, has stated vide note dated 21-08-2014, second read above that, the All India Council for Technical Education, New Delhi, has issued new regulations for approval process 2013-14 viz., the All India Council for Technical Education (Grant of Approvals for the Technical Institutions) Regulations, 2012 notified in the Gazette of India on 27th September, 2012. Section 4.34 – Para 4 of the said Regulations provide for students who have completed Bachelor's Degree of minimum 3 years duration in B.C.A., B.Sc., (Information Technology / Computer Science) with Mathematics as a course at 10 +2 level or at Graduate level shall be eligible for admission to second year M.C.A course up to a maximum of 20% of sanctioned intake which will be supernumerary of the approved intake in that course. Further, the Director of Higher and Technical Education has added that students who have completed Bachelor's Degree of minimum 3 years duration in B.C.A., B.Sc., (Information Technology / Computer Science) with Mathematics as a subject at 10 +2 level or at Graduate level shall be eligible for admission to second year M.C.A. course up to a maximum of 20% of sanctioned intake which will be supernumerary of the approved intake. The students have the option to choose either to get admitted in the First Year M.C.A course or in the II year of M.C.A. course under Lateral entry scheme based on their marks obtained in the Common Entrance Test for MCA course conducted by the "Centralised Admission Committee" (CENTAC – Post Graduate Degree Courses). The existing admission procedure for first year M.C.A. degree programme shall be adopted for lateral entry admission to M.C.A. degree programme as mentioned below :-

- (i) The "Centralised Admission Committee" (CENTAC – Post Graduate Degree Courses) constituted for the purpose of carrying out the task of admission of candidates to various Post Graduate Degree Courses offered in all the Government Colleges, Professional and Arts and Science Colleges run by Government sponsored Societies, Unaided Private Professional Colleges approved by the All India Council for Technical Education, New Delhi and also affiliated to Pondicherry University and to the M.C.A. degree programme offered in constituent Colleges of the Deemed Universities functioning in the Union Territory of Puducherry, shall handle admissions to second year of MCA degree course also.
- (ii) The ratio of apportionment of seats that is being followed by this Administration in so far as admission to First year M.C.A. course for all categories of Institutions (Government, Government Sponsored Society and Unaided Private Minority / Non-Minority Institutions), shall hold good for admission to second year M.C.A. course under Lateral Entry Scheme also.

(iii) Admission to Lateral Entry M.C.A., under Management quota in all the Unaided Private Professional Colleges approved by the All India Council for Technical Education, New Delhi and affiliated to Pondicherry University, Puducherry, will be regulated / monitored by the Permanent Admission Committee, constituted for the purpose of overseeing the admission of students to the Unaided Private Professional Colleges functioning in the Union Territory of Puducherry.

2. The Director of Higher and Technical Education, has requested to issue orders for lateral entry admission to M.C.A., degree programme in all the Government Colleges, Professional and Arts and Science Colleges run by Government sponsored Societies, Unaided Private Professional Colleges approved by the All India Council for Technical Education, New Delhi and also affiliated to Pondicherry University and to the M.C.A. degree programme offered in constituent Colleges of the Deemed Universities functioning in the Union Territory of Puducherry in accordance with All India Council for Technical Education Regulations, 2012 notified in the Gazette of India on 27th September, 2012 from the academic year 2015-16.

3. After careful examination, the Government have decided to accept the request of the Director of Higher and Technical Education in para 2 above and accordingly, the Lieutenant-Governor, Puducherry is pleased to order to introduce Lateral Entry admission to the II year of the M.C.A., programme from the academic year 2015-16 onwards in all the Government Colleges, Professional and Arts and Science Colleges run by Government sponsored Societies, Unaided Private Professional Colleges approved by the All India Council for Technical Education, New Delhi and also affiliated to Pondicherry University and to the M.C.A. degree programme offered in constituent Colleges of the Deemed Universities functioning in the Union Territory of Puducherry in accordance with Section 4.34 of All India Council for Technical Education (Grant of Approvals for the Technical Institutions) Regulations, 2012. The Director of Higher and Technical Education, Puducherry is instructed to adopt the existing admission procedures for first year M.C.A. degree programme, for the lateral entry (II Year) admission to M.C.A. degree programme also as enlisted below :-

(a) Students who have completed Bachelor's Degree of minimum 3 years duration in B.C.A., B.Sc., (Information Technology / Computer Science) with Mathematics as a subject at 10 +2 level or at Graduate level shall alone be eligible for admission to second year M.C.A., course (Lateral entry) up to a maximum of 20% of the sanctioned intake of seats, which will be supernumerary of the approved intake.

(b) The common entrance test for M.C.A. course, conducted by the Centralised Admission Committee (CENTAC) – Post Graduate Degree Courses, is common for admission to First year M.C.A., as well as Lateral entry M.C.A. The students have the option to choose either to get admitted to the First Year M.C.A., or in the II year of M.C.A. course under Lateral Entry scheme, based on the marks scored by them in the said Common entrance Test.

(c) The Centralised Admission Committee (CENTAC) for admission to Post Graduate Degree courses constituted by this Administration for handling issues relating to First year M.C.A., course admissions shall handle issues relating to admission to second year M.C.A., degree course under Lateral Entry Scheme, in the Government Quota seats allocated in all the Government Colleges, Professional and Arts and Science Colleges run by Government sponsored Societies, Unaided Private Professional Colleges approved by the All India Council for Technical Education, New Delhi and also affiliated to Pondicherry University and to the M.C.A. degree programme offered in constituent Colleges of the Deemed Universities functioning in the Union Territory of Puducherry.

(d) The ratio of apportionment of seats that is being followed by this Administration so far, in respect of First year M.C.A. course for all categories of Institutions (Government, Government Sponsored Society and Unaided Private Minority / Non-Minority Institutions), shall hold good for admission to second year M.C.A. course under Lateral Entry Scheme also.

(e) Admission to Lateral Entry M.C.A., course under Management quota in all the Unaided Private Professional Colleges approved by the All India Council for Technical Education, New Delhi and affiliated to Pondicherry University, Puducherry, will be regulated / monitored by the Admission Committee constituted for the purpose of overseeing the admission of students to the Unaided Private Professional Colleges functioning in the Union Territory of Puducherry.

4. The Director of Higher and Technical Education, Puducherry, the Convenor, CENTAC – (Post Graduate Degree Courses) and the Convenor, Centralised Admission Procedure for Arts and Science Courses (CAPASC), Puducherry are also instructed to issue necessary notification to invite applications for Lateral Entry admission to M.C.A. degree course from the academic year 2015-16.
