CHAPTER - 1

INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The following seventeen manuals are published as required under section 4 (b) of the Right to Information Act 2005. As per the provisions contained in the said Act, all the fisher community and public have the right to get information and therefore every public authority shall maintain all its records duly catalogued and indexed.
- 1.2 The objective / purpose of this handbook is to secure access to information to fishermen / public under the control of public authorities, in order to promote transparency and accountability in the working of every public authority, the appointment of Information officer, and Assistant Information Officers. To augment fish production, to improve the socio-economic status of the fisherfolk thereby increasing the employment generation besides focusing on technologies in culture and capture fishery sectors involving fishermen and private enterpreners to a larger extent.
- 1.3 All the fishermen / public of this Union Territory of Pondicherry can use this hand book.
- 1.4 This handbook gives information on the Department of Fisheries and Fishermen Welfare.

1.5 Definition:

- a) 'Director of Fisheries and Fishermen Welfare' means an officer appointed by the Government as the Head of the Department of Fisheries and Fishermen Welfare.
- b) 'Joint Director of Fisheries and Fishermen Welfare', means the Chief public Relation officer as well as the Nodal officer on technical subjects of the Department,

- c) 'Deputy Director of Fisheries and Fishermen Welfare' means the Chief Coordinator for implementation of Development Schemes / Programmes and achieving the fiscal and physical targets earmarked under the various scheme.
- d) 'Assistant Engineer (Marine)' means the Chief Officer of the service cum maintenance unit of the Department.
- e) 'Chief Refrigeration Supervisor' means the Chief Officer appointed for supervision of all the ice plant cum cold storages of the Department.
- f) 'Assistant Director of Fisheries' and Fishermen Welfare means the coordinator for implementation of various schemes / programmes
- g) 'Inspector of Fisheries and Fishermen Welfare' is the Chief Extension officer for spot inspection, enquiry and dissemination of information to the users.
- h) 'Sub-Inspector of Fisheries and Fishermen Welfare', is the Extension officer for spot inspection, enquiry, dissemination of information to the users.
- i) 'Master mechanic' is the staff appointed for attending the services of all the mechanised fishing vessels.
- j) 'Refrigeration supervisor' is appointed for supervision of the Departmental Ice plant of the respective region.
- k) 'Fitter' is appointed for master mechanic assisting Assistant Engineer and Master Mechanic.
- I) 'Refrigeration Operator' is appointed for operating the Ice plant cum Cold Storages.
- m) 'Iceman' is appointed for assisting the Refrigeration operator.
- n) 'Boat Fishery overseer' is appointed for assisting Sub-Inspector of Fisheries and Inspector of Fisheries for conducting spot enquiries of the fishermen applicant, distribution of free rice, clothing to fishermen families, maintenance of fish farm etc.
- o) 'Field man' is appointed for issue of demand notices, maintenance of fish farm, attending weather warning duties etc.
- p) 'Fishermen' is appointed for assisting field man and overseer in respect of all work related to fisheries.
- 1.6 The contact person in case somebody wants to get more information on topics covered in the Hand Book as well as other information also, is the Public Information officer and Assistant Public Information officers under the Right to Information Act 2005.

<u>CHAPTER -2 (manual -1)</u> PARTICULARS OF ORGANISATION, FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES

2.1 Objective/purpose of the public authority.

The Objective of the Department of Fisheries and Fishermen Welfare is to develop Fisheries and to improve the Socio-economic status of the fisher community.

2.2 Mission / Vision Statement of the public authority. One thereby

- i) To harvest the maximum unexploited fishery resources fromdeep sea offshore areas and to develop export zone thereby providing urban facilities in rural areas i.e in coastal villages -(PURA) -
- ii) To cover more inland water bodies and to encourage fresh water farmers to take up integrated fish farming. -
- iii) On the whole to uplift the socio -economic status of the fishermen community. -

2.3 Brief history of the public authority and context of its formation.

The Department of Fisheries and Fishermen Welfare was established in the year 1955 after the de-facto merger of the former Ex-French settlement with the Indian Union and development of fisheries activities in the Union Territory of Pondicherry was taken up.

2.4 Duties of the public authority

In addition to augmenting Fish Production, Fishermen Welfare Schemes are also implemented for overall upliftment of fisher community towards their contribution for the growth of economy in general.

2.5 Main activities/functions fo the public authority

Rendering of various assistances to fisher community and public wherever applicable.

2.6 List of services being provided by the public authority with a brief write-up on them.

The important activity of the Department is to augment fish production and to uplift the socio-economic status of the fishermen community by evolving and implementing various welfare programmes such as:

- i) Grant of Input subsidy to fresh water fish farmers to take up fish culture activities.
- ii) Grant of input and construction subsidy to aqua farmers to take up Brackish water fish farming with the approval of Aquaculture Authority.
- iii) Grant of subsidy to fishermen for procurement of mechanized fishing boats, wooden / FRP/ Marine plywood, country crafts and tackles.
- iv) Subsidy for procurement of auto goods carrier, mini fish van, etc., Integrated Fish Finder and Navigational Guidance System etc.,
- v) Imparting Training to fisherwomen and fishermen in State / Central Government Organizations, Creating awareness to fishermen and public about the various development programmes undertaken by the Department thro' Newspaper.
- vi) Financial assistance to fishermen cooperatives for strengthening of their activities.
- vii) Supply of fishery requisites like nylon twine, floats, sinkers etc., to fishermen at subsidized cost.
- viii) Various welfare measures like rendering assistance to fishermen families during lean season, during the period of ban on fishing, drought, assistance under savings cum relief scheme, insurance, old age pension etc.,

CHAPTER - 3 (Manual-2)

POWERS AND DUTIES OF OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES

The Administrative Powers/duties, functions and responsibilities pertaining to the Technical cadres are as detailed below:

DIRECTOR OF FISHERIES

- He is the Head of Department. -
- He is the controlling authority for all technical and Administrative functions. -
- . He is borne from the Pondicherry Civil Service (Selection Grade). -

JOINT DIRECTOR OF FISHERIES

- Act as the Chief Public Relations Officer as well as the Nodal Officer on technical subjects of the Department.
- * Responsible for casting and finalization of the Department's budget.
- ❖ Formulation of new and innovative schemes for furthering the Department's goals as well as in uplifting the socio-economic conditions of the fishermen.
- ❖ Will be head and chief coordinator for the R&d of the Department.
- ❖ Being head of the technical section, the Joint Director of Fisheries will actively assist the Head of the Department on both technical as well as administrative matters.
- Help in formulating/rendering suitable replies to Audit, PAC,CAS etc. as well as other technical reports Brought by Government of Pondicherry or other Agencies.
- Responsible for the achievement of both the fiscal and physical targets under Plan/ Non-Plan/Centrally Sponsored Schemes earmarked for the Department.
- Will attend top plan discussions with officials of Government of Pondicherry.
- Will conduct periodical review meeting on (a) Expenditure; (b) Scheme implementation; (c) Audit, PAC, OBA and other related matters.
- Will undertake surprise inspections of all sub-offices/units including outlying regions to monitor the different fishery activities of the Department.
- Discharge the function of Head of Department in the event of his leave/absence.
- Assisting the Head of Department in the running of cooperative Institutions working under the control of the Fisheries Department.

DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF FISHERIES

- Chief Co-coordinator among the various hierarchal cadres of the Department
- ❖ Fully responsible for implementation of Plan and Non-Plan schemes and achieving the fiscal and physical targets earmarked under various schemes.
- ❖ Will promote indigenisation of low cost but effective technology by frequent contacts with counterparts in the neighbouring states.
- Organise and attend seminars / workshops / symposiums exhibitions/training etc., to disseminate such technology to end users.
- ❖ Being generally a Head of Office as well as DDO, the Deputy Director of Fisheries will also be responsible for all duties delegated to such officers.

ASSISTANT DIRECTOR OF FISHERIES

- Help to formulate policies and schemes for furthering the Department's goals. -
- Process and supervise both technical and ministerial work. -
- * Responsible for taking up macro planning and casting of budgets. -
- Undertake frequent field visits to monitor progress and development of the schemes.
- Organise and undertake field/educational tours for fisherman/aquaculturists. Also conduct farmer's meet/workshops/seminars etc.
- ❖ Furnish Audit, PAC, OBA and other related particulars. Responsible for duties and responsibilities as Head of Office and DDO in the outlying regions of Mahe and Yanam as well as the Chief Executive Officer, Fish Farmers Development Agency.

ASSISTANT ENGINEER (MARINE)

- Over all incharge for proper functioning of the service cummaintenance units located at Pondicherry, Karaikal, and Mahe catering to the needs of more than 400 mechanised boats including FRP boats. -
- Direction control and supervision, inspection of the work of the Marine Foreman regarding the matters relating to the repairs of Marine Diesel Engines purchase and sales of spares, Inspection of new engines before and after installation in the hull and maintenance of all fish vans.

- Co-ordinate between the Deputy Director of Fisheries in respect of running of mechanized boats, engines and other matters like seizure of boats, condemnation of engines, disposal regarding etc.,
- Direction control and supervision of Fish vans of the scheme" Transport facilities to Fishermen" of Pondicherry Region and the staff.
- Obtaining sanctions for other outlying regions in respect of the above schemes.
- Any other works entrusted by the Directorate as and when arises.

CHIEF REFRIGERATION SUPERVISOR

 Chief Refrigeration supervisor will supervise and monitor all the Departmental Ice plant cum cold storage units in Pondicherry, Karaikal, Mahe and Yanam.

INSPECTOR OF FISHERIES

- Take steps to enhance the management and exploitation of the Department's fishery wealth.
- Be in constant touch with the end users for obtaining feedback on fishery technology imparted and will be a motivating force in field extension activities.
- Involved with the assessment of beneficiaries, distribution of mechanized vessels, country crafts, OBM nets, nylon, twine and other crafts and tackles to the fishermen
- Responsible for the collection of Departmental dues and its remittance.
- Strive for indigenous technology by developing R&D in aquaculture and allied fields.
- Conduct field trials of the technology so developed and impart information to the end users.
- Also evaluate the efficacy and applications of the various hi.tech gadgets and other devices involved in the present day aquacultural practices and submit periodical reports.
- Impart training on Ornamental Fish culture.
- Periodical inspection of Mechanised Boats and to undertaken relate registration work.

MARINE FOREMAN

- Maintenance of all files, log books, indent books, connected with the scheme " Transport facilities to Fishermen".
- Follow up action in the completion of repairs of Fish van carried out in the Government Automobile Workshop.
- Follow up action of collection of hire charges and inspection of vans at the place of operation.
- > Attending major and minor repair works of the marine engines allotted to the boat hirers at scheduled tariff.
- > Purchase of engine spares for sales to the fisherman. Maintenance of tools required for the unit and proper maintenance of the workshop.

SUB-INSPECTOR OF FISHERIES

- Vested with the work of Planning of the monthly schedule of the farms/aquacultural units and take all steps to anticipate and overcome any contingency in this regard. Maintenance and upkeep of the sections (Marine, Inland and Brackish water sections) attached to.
- Help in laboratory analysis of the physiochemical nature of the aquatic culture environment.
- Survey, existing and potential water bodies to enhance fish production.
- Will be the main extension worker for dissemination of latest techniques in the fishery field for end users.
- Assist in conducting breeding of prawns/fish by induced materials or other artificial breedings.
- * Assist in seizure of boats.
- Preparation of OD position of loanees, insurance dues etc.
- Conducting for surveys and collection of statistical data fish arrivals/prices/population etc.

MASTER MECHANIC

- Conducting of Training Classes of service mechanic (Marine) course under TRYSEM. -
- Assisting the Marine Foreman in all his duties. -
- > Inspection of boats at the place of operation. -
- > Attending to service and repairs of mechanized boats. -

REFRIGERATION SUPERVISOR

- ❖ The Refrigeration Supervisor has to supervise all the machineries, equipment installed at the particular Ice plant-cum-storage unit, in which he is posted / attached.
- ❖ The Refrigeration Supervisor is also responsible for the regular sales of Ice bars produced in the Iceplant for the fish vending fisher-folk.
- ❖ The Refrigeration Supervisor is therefore responsible for the maintenance of sales book, cash register etc., and also he is specially responsible to collect the day-to-day cash and to remit the collected cash regularly to the office concerned daily and to obtain proper acknowledgement.
- The Refrigeration Supervisor is also responsible for timely submission of Reports / Returns relating to the plant in which he is attached.

REFRIGERATION OPERATOR

- The Refrigeration Operator has to maintain all machineries equipments of the Ice-Plant and to watch the water level of cooling tower, condenser and density of brine solution.
- The Refrigeration Operator is also responsible for daily checking of oil level in gauge glass, side feed Lubricator oil measure at seal end of compressor.
- The Refrigeration Operator has to maintain the Ammonia Gas circulation into the system periodically.
- The Refrigeration Operator should attend any repair for maintenance of machineries at any time under the supervision of Refrigeration Supervisor.
- The Refrigeration Operator has to maintain log book, Ice sales register of the Ice-Plant during his duty time.

BOAT FISHERY OVERSEER

- Undertake all pre-stocking, stocking and post stocking farm/culture management practices
- Participate in effectively exploiting the fishery wealth.
- Responsible for preparation of feed and feeding of fishes.
- Help in Survey of Culture sites, compilation of aquacultural/ fish landing data and other statistics.
- □ Attend to issue of O.D., insurance, weather and other related notices besides help in seizure of boats.

FITTER

- * Assisting the marine foreman and the master mechanic in all their -
- duties. -
- Inspection of boats at the place of operation. -
- * Incharge of maintenance and upkeep of all the fish farm machineries -
- and equipments. -
- * Assisting the Marine Foreman in the repairs of machanised boats. -

FIELDMAN

- Prawn/Fish Seed prospecting.
- Safe and effective packing of the seeds under oxygen for transport.
- Preparation and storage of feed materials, supervision of the works of the fisherman
- Distribution of weather warning, over due, insurance and other notices to the fishermen.
- Attend all other duties of the fish farm maintenance.

FISHERMAN

- > Preparation of nursery ponds and rearing ponds for stocking of fish seed.
- > Natural collection of fish seed from rivers during floods.
- > Maintenance of Government Fish Farm and Cleaning them.
- > Applying of fertilizers, manure in the Fish ponds to develop natural food to the Fish seeds.
- > Daily feeding of fishes with fish feed and trial netting of fishes for observation of fish growth and fish disease .
- > Harvesting of table fish for sales to public. Mending of damaged nets.
- > Serving of Demand notices to loan holders (Nava/Housing)

ICEMAN

- The Iceman of the Ice-Plant should deliver the Ice by lifting the ice from brine tank after made of proper receipt. He has to attend the regular duties like filling up of water in the ice cans, condenser cleaning, cleaning of cooling tower and brine tank. Applying of grease and lubricating all the machineries on the supervision of Refrigeration Operator or Refrigeration Supervisor.
- The Iceman has to assist the Refrigeration Operator and Refrigeration Supervisor during the time of attending repairs to Compressor and other machineries.

The Administrative powers / duties , functions and responsibilities in respect of the Senior Accounts Officer, Junior Accounts Officer, Superintendent, and other Ministerial Staff are same as in other Departments.

Financial powers:

The Financial powers of Head of Department, Head of Office and Drawing and Disbursing Officers are as detailed in the delegation of Financial Power Rules.

Two types of programes are available viz., EDFVC (Engine Driver Fishing Vessel Course) and MFVC (Mate Fishing Vessel Course). The candidates are trained in different fields of fishery like the

mechanism of the boats, attending of repairs occurring in the vessels, knowledge in the availability of fish shoals and handling of latest equipments in the fishing vessels etc at different Institutes of Central Institute of Fisheries Nautical Engineering Training at Visakapatinam, Kochi and Chennai.


