The Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi permitted the Government of Puducherry to adopt same norms / ceilings as laid down by the Government of India in the matter of payment of ex-gratia relief to the victims of natural calamities from Calamity Relief Fund (CRF) & National Calamity Contingency Fund (NCCF) vide reference first cited. Accordingly, Government of Puducherry notified the list of items and norms of assistance, for the payment to the affected people (under CRF & NCCF) and subsequent revision of the same vide G.Os 2nd, 3rd and 4th cited above.

- 2. As provided in section 48(1)(a) of the Disaster Management Act,2005, the State Governments were advised by Government of India to constitute State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) by transferring the balance funds available under Calamity Relief Fund existing as on 31.3.2010. Consequently, CRF has ceased to exist. Similarly, Government of India have merged the existing National Calamity Contingency Fund (NCCF) into National Disaster Response Fund (NDRF).
- 3. The Disaster Management Division, Ministry of Home Affairs have notified the revised items and norms of assistance from SDRF/NDRF for the period 2010-2015 based on the recommendations of the 13th Finance Commission and the report of an Expert group Constituted by the Ministry of Home Affairs in supersession of the Ministry's earlier notifications in the letter 6th cited above.
- 4. As per the directions of Ministry of Home Affairs, the State Disaster Response Fund shall be used only for meeting the expenditure for providing immediate relief to the victims of cyclone, drought, earthquake, fire, flood, tsunami, hailstorm, landslide, avalanche, cloud burst and pest attack.

- 5. Now, the Ministry of Home Affairs (Disaster Management Division), New Delhi, in the letter 8th above, has decided to further revise the norms in respect of (i) S.No. 9(a)(i) i.e. repair/restoration of fully damaged/destroyed Pucca houses from Rs. 35000/- per unit to Rs. 70,000/- per unit (ii) S.No. 1(e) i.e. provision of Gratuitous relief for families in dire need of immediate sustenance after a calamity (iii) S.No. 5(i) (B) (a) & (b) and 5 (ii) i.e. provision of input subsidy to SMF and OSMF (where crop loss is 50% and above) in respect of rainfed, irrigated and perennial crops and (iv) S.No. 6 (ii) & (iii) i.e. "provision of fodder/feed concentrate and water supply in cattle camps", in supersession of the Ministry's letter read 6th cited above. APPENDIX

(Item No. 10)

Illustrative list of activities identified as of an immediate nature.

1. Drinking Water Supply:

- i) Repair of damaged platforms of hand pumps/ring wells/ spring-tapped chambers/public stand posts, cisterns.
- ii) Restoration of damaged stand posts including replacement of damaged pipe lengths with new pipe lengths, cleaning of clear water reservoir (to make it leak proof).
- iii) Repair of damaged pumping machines, leaking overhead reservoirs and water pumps including damaged intake structure, approach gantries/jetties.

2. Roads

- i) Filling up of breaches and potholes, use of pipe for creating waterways, repair and stone pitching of embankments.
- ii) Repair of breached culverts.
- iii) Providing diversions to the damaged/washed out portions of bridges to restore immediate connectivity.
- iv) Temporary repair of approaches to bridges/embankments of bridges, repair of damaged railing bridges, repair of causeways to restore immediate connectivity, granular sub base, over damaged stretch of roads to restore traffic.

3. Irrigation:

- i) Immediate repair of damaged canal structures and earthen/masonry works of tanks and small reservoirs with the use of cement, sand bags and stones.
- ii) Repair of weak areas such as piping or rat holes in dam walls/ embankments.
- iii) Removal of vegetative material/building material/debris from canal and drainage system.

4. Health:

Repair of damaged approach roads, buildings and electrical lines of PHCs/ community Health Centres.

5. Community assets of Panchayat

- a) Repair of village internal roads.
- b) Removal of debris from drainage/sewerage lines.
- c) Repair of internal water supply lines.
- d) Repair of street lights.
- e) Temporary repair of primary schools, Panchayat ghars, community halls, anganwadi, etc.

	Repair/restoration (of immediate nature) of damaged infrastructure: (1) Roads & bridges (2)Drinking Water Supply Works, (3) Irrigation, (4) Power (only limited to immediate restoration of electricity supply in the affected areas), (5)Schools, (6)Primary Health Centres, (7) Community assets owned by Panchayat. Sectors such as Telecommunication and Power (except immediate restoration of Power supply), which generate their own revenues, and also undertake immediate repair/ restoration works from their own funds/ resources, are excluded.	Activities of immediate nature: Illustrative lists of activities which may be considered as works of an immediate nature are given in the enclosed Appendix. Assessment of requirements: Based on assessment of need, as per States' costs/ rates/ schedules for repair, by SEC and recommendation of the Central Team (in case of NDRF). - As regards repair of roads, due consideration shall be given to Norms for Maintenance of Roads in India, 2001, as amended from time to time, for repairs of roads affected by heavy rains/floods, cyclone, landslide, sand dunes, etc. to restore traffic. For reference these norms are • Normal and Urban areas: upto 15% of the total of Ordinary Repair (OR) and Periodical Repair (PR). • Hills: upto 20% of total of OR and PR. Note: States shall first use its provision under the budget for regular maintenance and repair.
11.	PROCUREMENT	
	Procurement of essential search, rescue and evacuation equipments including communication equipments, etc. for response to disaster.	 Expenditure is to be incurred from SDRF only (and not from NDRF), as assessed by the State Executive Committee (SEC). The total expenditure on this item should not exceed 5% of the annual allocation of the SDRF.

- 6. For the purpose of assessing the damage of the house, if the house is beyond repair and needs to be re-constructed it shall be classified as fully damaged house. Similarly, if the extent of damage is at least 50%, it shall be classified as severely damaged house and if the extent of damage is at least 15%, it shall be classified as Partially Damaged house. As a general principle, the size and area of the house shall be taken in to consideration in determining the damage assessment.
- 7. This order comes into force with retrospective effect from 1st March 2013.
