- With Clean public Places, Offices etc

Factors affecting Sanitation Environment

- Broken roads, pavements, footpaths
- Improper / delayed restoration of digging
- Encroachments on streets leading to difficulty in servicing
- Littering on streets, markets.
- Inadequate/ Improper sweeping of Roads & markets
- Defacement of public properties

Factors affecting Sanitation Environment (Cont'd)

- Insanitary Conditions in Public Properties (Parks, Schools, Dispensaries) & Other Government Buildings
- Broken drains, choked drains, improper design of drains, Lack of UGD, Non Connection to UGD
- On-going works leading to digging of roads
- Dug Roads left as it is causing water-logging
- Encroachments on drains leading to difficulty in servicing

Factors affecting Sanitation Environment (Cont'd)

- Poor conditions of Public & Community Toilets
- Inadequate maintenance & cleaning of Public & Community toilets
- Mosquito breeding in water collected at various places

Poor Maintenance of Infrastructure	Outsourcing, SHG Involvement, Proposal for Adoption by Industries, Trade Organisations
Poor Service Delivery	Ramping up of the existing Service Delivery Mechanism to improvise the Service Delivery
Lack of Adequate System of Penalties and Incentives	Proposal of Imposing Fine for littering etc. in Public Places like in South Delhi Municipal Corporation


